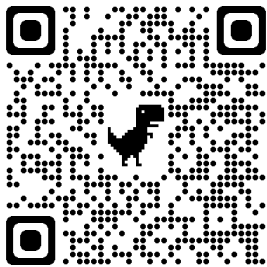
Recent Car Break-Ins
